2. We think we could build an app together which would tell young people where the nearest activities are and also use social media for consultation
3. We want to do something together to deal with all of the motorbike issues. We don't want anyone else to die.

P&C NP Response

- Tasked its Health & Wellbeing subgroup to link with PYP & drive progress. C&F offered support too.
- Progress update to NP by end 2014
- Delivering more youth friendly Health Services for young people has been included as a **priority in LCP 2014.**

PYP - Progress so far

- PYP attending East Headroom Meeting on 7 November.
- Clinical Leads are to meet with PYP to begin discussing mental health Services
- Links now building with C&D medical centre who want to pilot work with 12 – 16 year olds – PYP may act as ‘critical friend ‘
- Potential work with PYP with Chalmers re Sexual Health drop-in clinics
- PYP now looking at other emerging issues e.g. mens’ health and support.

Challenges/Questions

- Clearly a cross-cutting issue with direct impact/links to other NP sub-groups e.g. Children & Families, Community Safety – how can we plan/work together to deliver and measure more holistic outcomes?
- How do we all work better together on cross-cutting issues?
- How can the Strategic Partnerships improve support for relevant local work?
