Briefing Note to Neighbourhood Partnership – 26 February 2014

NEP Updates 2013/14

- Path from Craigmillar Castle to the Castle –this was still on course to be complete in the summer;
- Distance markers on the Prom – costs of £2,000 had been received which were within budget. The mile would begin at Tumbles in the west and stretch to the Joppa end of the prom. The one kilometre mark was at the Community Garden, where the Coade pillars stood. The stones would take 6 weeks to prepare, and would be installed in August;
- Abercorn crossing – this was with Procurement and was waiting for a Road Safety Audit. This should be completed by early June and would be installed in the summer.
