## **NP progress/development in past year**

- Commitment/regular feedback re: new High School(s)
- Maintained Extended School Holiday Programme
- Sub-group action/support for successful Castlebrae Business Centre regeneration grant
- Sub-group has developed clear links with BioQuarter Project Group & plans
- Support for the development/installation of Helen Crummy statue

# P&C NP LCP 2014/17

## Main consultation findings

- **Edinburgh Peoples Survey (top 5)** –road improvements/safety, activities for children/young people, dog-fouling, clean area and more affordable housing
- **NP local consultation** - activities for young people, clean area, dog-fouling, safety, housing and schools
- **Local Policing Plan** - antisocial behaviour, housebreaking/ theft, drug dealing/abuse and assault/violent crime
- **Youth Gathering** - safety in parks/on streets, use of the astroturf pitch at Castlebrae, youth provision later in evenings, better relations between older/younger people, more 'youth-friendly' (mental) health services and to help build a new Craigmillar
- **Portobello Community Council** - less litter/dog-fouling, less traffic congestion , new High School and better local shops
