

# MANAGING CHILDREN'S BEHAVIOUR

There are **still places available** on our Managing Children's Behaviour course on Friday 28 May, 9.30-11.30am.

This course is suitable for unemployed people who are interested in pursuing a career in childcare and for parents / carers who wish to enhance their childcare knowledge and skills.

## Course Description

1 x 2 hour session covering the following: -

- Identifying wanted and unwanted behaviours
- An insight into the possible reasons why children display both wanted and unwanted behaviours
- A tool box of ideas which can be used to promote wanted behaviour and manage unwanted behaviour.

All courses will be delivered from the Training suite within North Edinburgh Childcare at 18B Ferry Road Avenue, Edinburgh, EH4 4BL. This course cost is set at a subsidised rate of £30.00 per session as a result of funding received from the Third Sector Enterprise Fund.

Individuals may be able to undertake our courses **FREE OF CHARGE** if they open a learner account with ILA Scotland. It's a Scottish Government scheme for people over 16, with an income of £22,000 a year or less or who are on benefits to get up to £200 a year towards the cost of learning something new.
