Customer Information and Research

Inverleith Neighbourhood Partnership

The Inverleith neighbourhood is part of the north area of Edinburgh. Recent estimates of population say that 29,639 residents live in this area. The Inverleith Neighbourhood Partnership includes only one electoral ward and 400 residents were interviewed in this area in 2009.

Resident priorities for improvement / best things

Residents were asked what they thought was the best thing about their neighbourhood and what they would most like to see improved. Residents were able to name more than one thing.

Biggest changes from last year

The following indicators had statistically significant changes in satisfaction from 2008 to 2009. The five largest changes are shown – or if less than five are shown, all statistically significant changes have been listed.

Largest increases

1. Library services (+31%)
2. Primary schools (+26%)
3. Dealing with neighbour disputes (+25%)
4. Secondary schools (+25%)
5. Nursery schools (20%)

Largest decreases

1. Maintenance of roadways (-42%)
2. Social housing provision (-38%)
3. Maintenance of pavements (-24%)
4. Feels safe after dark (-17%)
5. Recycling facilities (-15%)

Three-year trend

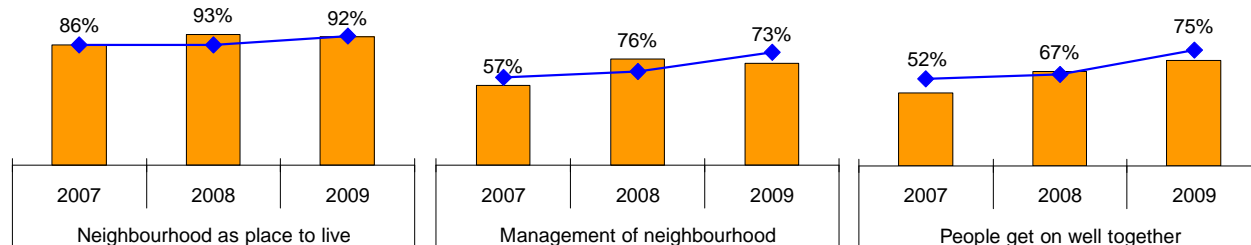
From 2007 to 2009, the overall trend in resident satisfaction with the Inverleith area and the services provided there is shown below.

| Satisfaction with 14 indicators increased over the three years | Satisfaction with 12 indicators stayed about the same over the three years | Satisfaction with 3 indicators fell over the three years |

Overall, residents were more satisfied with Inverleith and the services delivered there than they were three years ago. The full breakdown for all of this neighbourhood's indicators, showing all the scores and the city average, is provided on the following pages.

Percentage satisfied with the neighbourhood in general



Satisfaction with the neighbourhood as a place to live increased significantly over the three years covered by the survey. Satisfaction with the way the neighbourhood is managed and agreement that the area is one where people from different backgrounds can get on well together increased significantly over the three years.



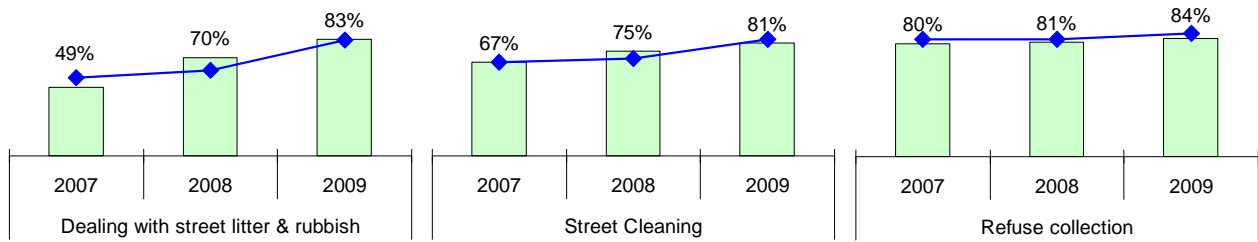
41% of residents felt they could influence local decisions and service provision; this is about the same as the city-wide figure. Over three years the percentage who have volunteered or given unpaid help in this area has fallen significantly.

In Inverleith only three respondents had taken part in a survey or consultation on local issues in the previous year. When asked if they would like the opportunity to have their say on things happening or the ways things are run locally, 13% said they would, but most did not say how they would like to be involved (only 1% said by survey).

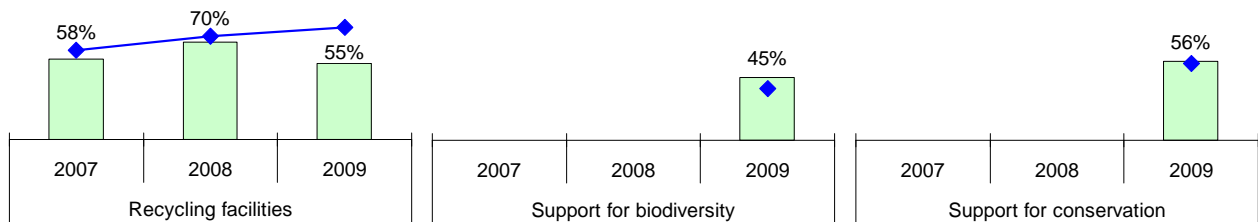
When asked if they wanted to hear more about things happening in their local area, 44% (177 people) said they would. These 177 people were asked how they would like to hear more and they said through Outlook (74%) and by post (9%).

Most Inverleith residents surveyed (85%) said they felt confident in knowing how to report an issue that affected them personally to the council. This is significantly higher than the city average of 74%.

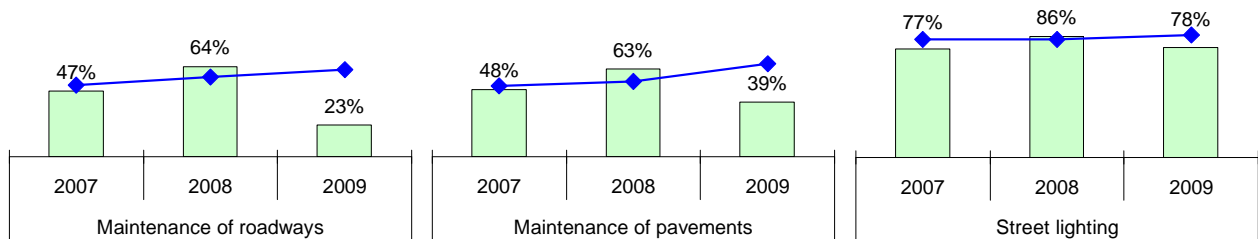
Percentage satisfied environmental services and cleanliness



Satisfaction with litter management and street cleaning increased significantly over the three years of the survey. Satisfaction with refuse collection stayed about the same. All three indicators are now about the same as the city average.



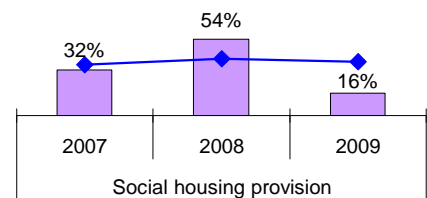
Satisfaction with recycling facilities in this area stayed about the same over the three years and is now significantly below the city average. 45% of respondents were satisfied with the way the council supports biodiversity in this area and this is above the city average. 56% were satisfied with the council's support for conservation and this is about the same as the city-wide average.



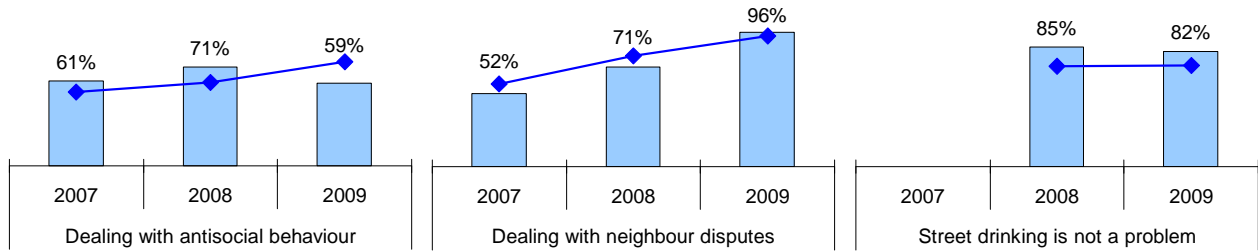
Satisfaction with road and pavement maintenance have fallen significantly over the three years, with all of the fall coming in between 2008 and 2009. Satisfaction with street lighting stayed about the same. All three indicators are now below the city average.

Satisfaction with social housing provision

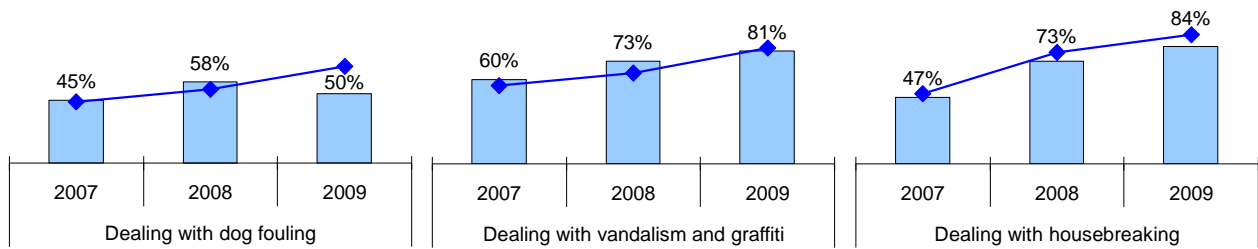
Satisfaction with the provision of council and housing association property in this area has fallen significantly over the three years. Satisfaction in 2009 is below the city-wide average.



Satisfaction with the way crime and antisocial behaviour are dealt with

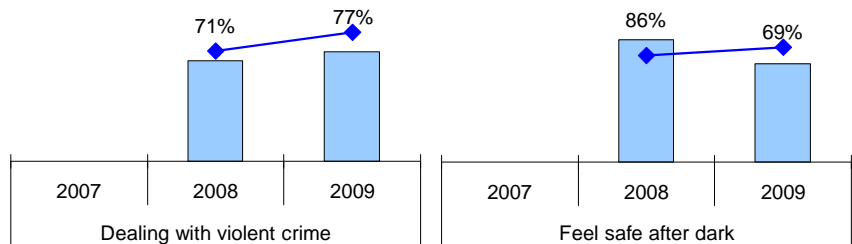


Satisfaction with the way antisocial behaviour is dealt with stayed about the same. Satisfaction with the way neighbourhood disputes were dealt with increased significantly and at a higher rate than the city average. The number of people who said street drinking and alcohol-related disorder were not problems in the area stayed about the same over the two years in which this question has been asked.

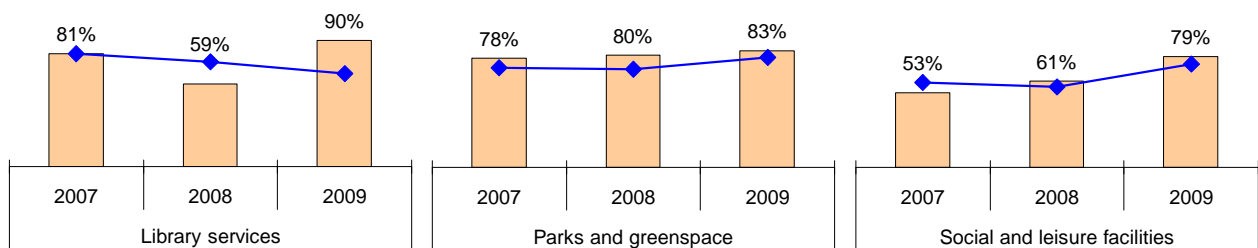


Satisfaction with the way dog fouling is dealt with stayed about the same and is now significantly below the city average. Satisfaction with the way vandalism and graffiti and housebreaking were dealt with increased significantly over the three years covered by the survey.

Satisfaction with the way violent crime is dealt with stayed about the same. The proportion of residents who feel safe in this area after dark has fallen. Both of these are below the city-wide average.

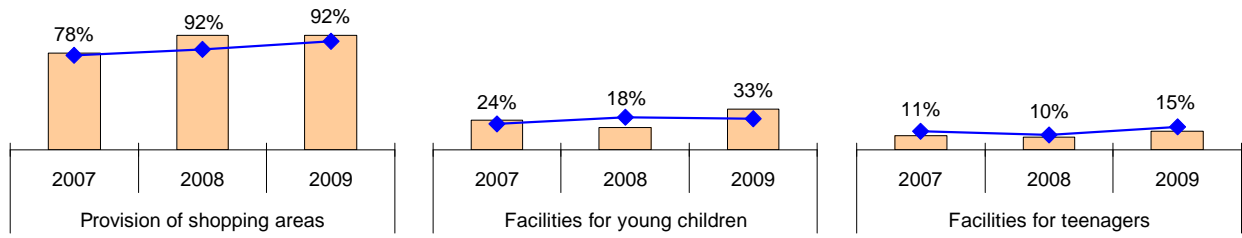


Satisfaction with community facilities

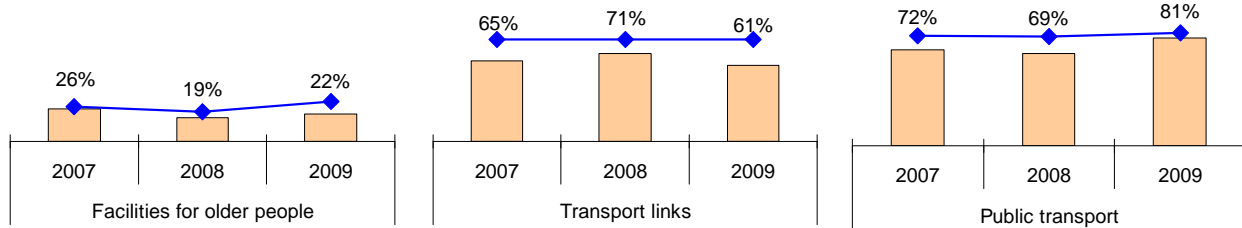


Satisfaction with libraries and social and leisure facilities increased significantly over the three years. Satisfaction with parks stayed about the same.

Inverleith is the only area of Edinburgh to have seen satisfaction with libraries increase over three years. The recent Public Library User Survey (PLUS) revealed that 90% of people who had used Stockbridge Library rated it as good or very good. While these percentage ratings were similar, it should be noted that the ANS is a survey of all the people in Edinburgh, while PLUS is a survey only of current library users.

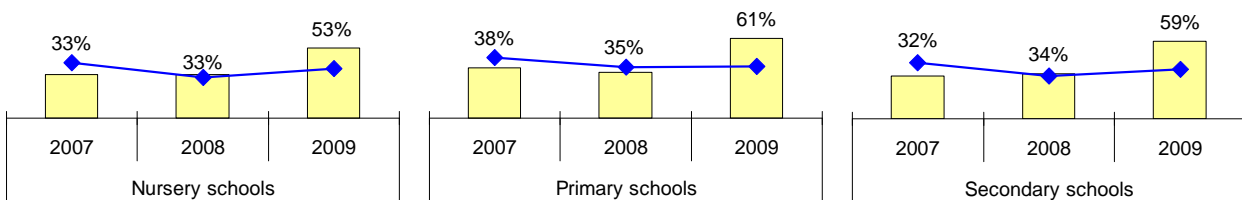


Satisfaction with the provision of shopping areas increased over three years. Satisfaction with facilities for young children and teenagers remained about the same over the three years.



Satisfaction with facilities for older people and satisfaction with transport links stayed about the same over the three years and both are below the city average. Satisfaction with public transport increased significantly and is now about the same as the city average, after being below it in 2007 and 2008.

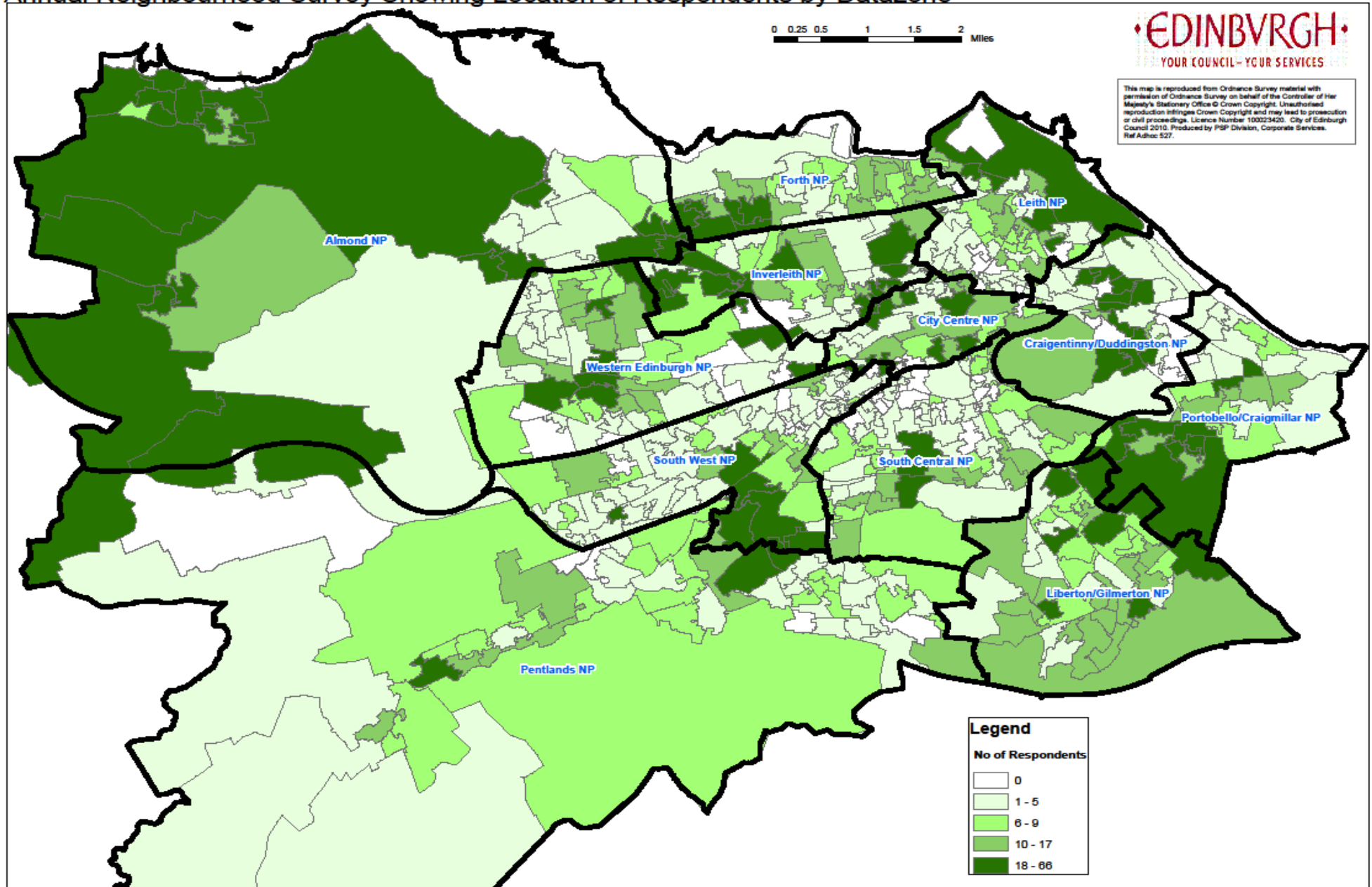
Satisfaction with council schools



Satisfaction with council-run nursery, primary and secondary schools in the area increased over the three years covered by the survey. All three indicators are above the city average in 2009.
