Inverleith Neighbourhood Partnership is calling for proposals for our bank of potential environmental improvement projects to be funded under the Neighbourhood Environment Programme (NEP).

**Projects proposed must be on land or assets held by Services for Communities (SfC).**

This includes:

- common areas such as bin store areas, stair entrances, drying greens
- public realm land assets held on an SfC account such as garage areas, grassed areas, roads, footpaths and other open spaces

Examples of current projects being developed include:

- Drylaw Recreation Ground,
- Pavement and railing improvements at Stockbridge Library,
- Work on roundabout at Groathill Road North,
- Saunders Street landscape improvements
- Path works at Portgower Place, and
- Traffic light works at Craigcrook Road

Proposals can be submitted by any community group, with support of Community Council, and should be submitted using this proposal form.
