



Additional Criteria

All applicants to the Grant a Grand fund will need to satisfy conditions as applied to the Community Grants Fund. In addition they will also need to satisfy the following.

- Costs in the application should total £1000.
- If applying on behalf of young people, applicants should demonstrate youth involvement in the development of their application.
- Applicants are required to complete an A4 pro-forma available on the Neighbourhood Partnership website. This should explain the application and accompany voting material, and consist of,
 - description of the group applying,
 - what they want the money for, and
 - how it will benefit local young people
- It is anticipated that no more than sixteen applications will go forward the Grant a Grand vote. If there are more than sixteen applications submitted they will be selected by those that best fit priorities in the South West Local Community Plan and ensure the widest spread across age groups and geography. This will be confirmed by the Grant a Grand arbiter with the support of the Partnership team.
- Those not selected to go forward to the public vote will be considered by the funding panel in early 2016.
